

About IAST: India Association of Southeast Texas (IAST) is a non-profit organization been in existence for over 25 years. It promotes cultural awareness in our community, extends charitable donations locally, nationally, and internationally, and encourages various activities which honor educational, social, and occupational achievements not only in our organization but across various communities and organizations. Every year it is the organization's goal to extend an understanding between various cultures, races and ethnicities through numerous activities.

Many of the activities held throughout the year also yield proceeds which are in turn, utilized not only to sustain our organization, but to promote other causes in the local area, such as Boys Haven, Beaumont Police Department, and the Beaumont Fire Department, to name just a few. Our membership has been a consistent supporter of charities like March of Dimes and American Cancer Society for the last 20 years. We have also raised funds to provide international and national relief for areas often devastated by natural calamities, e.g., Haiti (earthquake devastation), Hurricane Rita, Oklahoma (tornado devastation), etc.

The youth in our organization are active and are an integral part of the success. They are highly encouraged to participate in activities through fundraising, presenting various cultural dances or artwork, participating in walks/runs, sports activities, becoming a spokesperson for, and taking on leadership roles on the board and their schools. We, in turn, highlight their achievements through various venues.

About Board of Directors: IAST is governed by its bylaws. The Board of Directors are elected/selected every year to help with planning and organizing events throughout the year. Fiscal year is from January to December. Board includes, President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Cultural Directors, Building Director, Newsletter Editor, Web Master, Sports Director, Social Services Director, Public Relations Officer and Youth Director (teenager). The bylaws also require Board of Trustees which consists of past Presidents of IAST.

About Events: IAST conducts and participates in a host of events starting from Republic Day of India in January till Christmas in December. IAST Sponsors about half the events and the IAST Members sponsor rest of the events. Typical yearly events include – Republic Day of India, Valentines Day, Shiv Ratri, Hoil/Lodhi, IAST Picnic, Youth Night, Ugaadi/Gudipadva, Ramanavami, Independence Day of India, Janmasthanmi, Ganesh Chaturthi, Navarathri/Durga Puja, Diwali and Christmas Party. Charitable Event participation includes March of Dimes, Cancer Walk, Local 5K's and Marathons for charity and hosting of sports events like Table Tennis, Tennis, Cricket, Raquet Ball and Golf. Few elective Events include New Year Party, Super Bowl Party, Ask the Doc/Health Fair and any other event that benefits Religiously, Culturally or Health & Wellness of the IAST Membership.

About India Cultural Center (ICC): India Cultural Center located on Major Drive. All the IAST events (except sports events and picnics) are held on these premises. ICC can be rented by members and non-members. Please note that for members an additional discount is provided if it is a Religious Event.

About India Fest: For the past 23 years, the 300+ strong and vibrant Indian American Community of Southeast Texas has organized "India Fest" at the Beaumont Civic center as an attempt to provide the area residents, a glimpse into India. "India Fest" showcases Indian Culture, Fashion, Music, Dance & Food. It also serves as a fundraiser for our active participation in various charitable organizations including March of Dimes, Boys Haven, Beaumont Police and Fire Departments, and American Cancer Society through its' annual Cancer Walk event.
